DOGRI LANGUAGE AND SCRIPT

► Language is an identity of a man. It has emerged as one of the significant markers of cultural identity in fascinating multi ethnic, multi cultural and multi lingual and communities living in the region of Jammu and Kashmir. Jammu and Kashmir was a Dogra state. Jammu is a Dogra region with Dogri as its mother tongue. Dogri is as old as other languages.

► Dogri language has been rapidly developing as a literary language in recent year. In December 2003, it was given official recognition on the 8th scheduled of the Indian constitution. Several companies have already began providing Dogri translation services over the internet. It is also begin as a subject to school children throughout the Dogri speaking area. Jammu University is actively involved in standardising the languages and promoting its use.

► **Dogri script**– Dogri was once written in “**Dogra Akkhar**”, the official script of Jammu and Kashmir during the reign of Maharaja Ranbir Singh 1857-1885.

► However, Dogri was for the most part replaced by Devanagari script during the 20th Century.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

- Inclusions of Dogri in 8th scheduled opened up good chance for Dogri language and achieve significant level of advancement.
- The aim is to enrich the language not only in term of syntax but also in its civilization content.
