# **Department of Economics: Introduction**

- The Department of Economics accommodated its first batch of undergraduate students in the academic year 2020-21. Initially, 20 students opted Economics as one of their core subjects. Thereafter, in the next academic year, i.e. 2021-22, 18 students opted for Economics as one of their core subjects. In the same academic year, 15 students of Semester-V opted for a Generic Elective course in Economics.
- In the current academic year, i.e. 2022-23, the department accommodates a total of 53 students, 18 in Semester-II (Core course), 20 in Semester-IV (Core course), and 15 in Semester-VI (Generic Elective course).
